The Ardmore 2008 from Signatory Vintage is a Highland whisky which, with its 13 years of maturation, impressively demonstrates how complex and exciting the smoky whiskies from the Ardmore distillery can be.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

This whisky reveals its smoky soul from the very first contact. A dense peaty flavour is combined with notes of tobacco and a fascinating iodine component reminiscent of a maritime adventure. At the same time, a sweet vanilla note resonates, giving the flavour profile a gentle balance.

PALATE

In the mouth, the Ardmore 2008 unfolds with an oily, almost creamy texture. The campfire flavour is present, but not overwhelming, rather embedded in fruity-salty nuances. The fruitiness is reminiscent of juicy pears and a hint of pineapple, which blend surprisingly harmoniously with the smoky character

FINISH

The finish is of medium length and leaves a pleasant smoky note, accompanied by salty and maritime tones. It feels like a cool sea breeze after a night by the campfire - a harmonious end.
