## BenRiach 21 Years

This whisky offers a multifaceted tasting experience that combines earthy and fruity notes, complemented by a pleasant spiciness. The harmonious balance of mineral saltiness and sweet accents creates an elegant finish that underscores the complexity and accessibility of this Speyside.

### TASTING NOTES

#### NOSE

From the very first contact with the glass, we are enveloped by an inviting aroma reminiscent of a warm campfire, invigorating the senses with a grassy freshness. As the scents unfold, the nose glides over salty sea breezes accompanied by seaweed and a hint of honey, adding an earthy depth. The warmth of the aroma is complemented by the zesty note of orange peel, which breaks through the complex aroma like a ray of sunshine, brightening the overall impression. Here, a harmonious balance emerges that skillfully weaves together both the smoky and sweet elements, heightening the anticipation for the next sip.

#### PALATE

On the palate, a harmonious symphony of earthy and fruity notes unfolds, immediately reminiscent of juicy peaches. As the texture gently develops, a hint of ginger joins in, invigorating the senses and introducing a pleasant spiciness. This spiciness is accompanied by a subtle note of licorice and black pepper, adding an exciting depth to the experience, while maritime accents and salty nuances round out the complexity. In the background, a honey-sweet softness resonates, elegantly enveloping the tannins without creating bitterness, leaving a balanced and inviting impression.

#### FINISH

In the finish, a fascinating balance of mineral saltiness and a hint of black pepper remains, reminiscent of the coastal landscapes that shaped this whisky. This dry note gently lingers, imparting a subtle depth to the experience, while the memories of licorice and maritime freshness slowly recede. A sense of elegance lingers, reminiscent of the gentle waves of the sea, caressing the senses in a pleasant way. Here, the masterful integration of flavors is evident, highlighting both the complexity and accessibility of this Speysider, making it an unobtrusive yet impressive enjoyment.
