## Blended Scotch Whisky 15 Years (2024) - Living Souls

The Blended Scotch Whisky Release 2024 from Living Souls is a fascinating fusion of two outstanding components: 50% Glenrothes and 50% North British. With 15 years of maturation and a pleasant drinking strength of 46% vol., this whisky promises a good balance between complexity and accessibility. But does it deliver what it promises? A closer look at the aroma, flavour and finish reveals more.

### TASTING NOTES

#### NOSE

The very first aroma surprises with a fresh, lively note. Honey and a malty, almost cereal-like sweetness dominate, accompanied by a hint of red fruit and a delicate orange marmalade. Berries and red fruits lend the bouquet a fruity liveliness, while a light chocolate note and a hint of rye provide depth. Complex and inviting.

#### PALATE

The whisky is creamy and spicy on the palate. Grapefruit and a delicate dark chocolate harmonise with a subtle date sweetness and a hint of black pepper. Red fruits and brown sugar provide a pleasant sweetness, while turmeric and a dry spiciness round off the flavour. A nice balance between sweet and strong.

#### FINISH

The finish is tingling and lively, with a pleasant gingerbread spice and a slightly oaky note. Medium-long and sweet, it nevertheless remains balanced without being overpowering.

### THOUGHTS

#### MARCEL

A whisky that's a lot of fun, delighting with its spicy depth and sweet-fruity notes – perfect for enjoyable evenings and fans of complex yet approachable blends. The lively character and subtle sherry touch deliver drinking pleasure with plenty of punch. Add a scoop of hazelnut ice cream, and the evening is saved!

#### SASCHA

The 15-years blended Scotch from Living Souls strikes a successful balance between sweet fruit aromas and spicy notes, supported by a subtle sherry influence. Its structured aromatics and well-balanced, medium-length finish make it a solid example of complex blends with good drinking strength. Overall, a harmoniously composed whisky that showcases its strengths through a multifaceted flavor profile.
