Cigar Malt 14 Years (2024) The Tasteful 8 - Brühler Whiskyhaus

Some whiskies are for drinking, others for savouring - and then there are the whiskies that simply go perfectly with a good cigar because they hardly differ from it in taste.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

Rich caramel meets ripe banana and a deep leather note. These are joined by honeyed dates, which add a pleasant sweetness. The distinct red fruit component is particularly exciting - a hint of berries that gives the whisky a complex, elegant flavour. A flavour that is best imagined with a freshly cut cigar in your hand.

PALATE

The dried fruits, especially plums and dates, provide a full, rich base. But then comes the real star: tobacco. The flavour is reminiscent of a well-matured cigar leaf - spicy, slightly earthy and with a pleasant dryness. Old leather adds an extra dimension and provides a touch of nostalgia, like sinking into an old leather armchair in front of a fireplace.

FINISH

This shows why this whisky has earned the name Cigar Malt. The finish is slightly earthy, with a pleasant leatheriness and a subtle burnt note reminiscent of caramelised cask edges. There is also an intense spiciness that lingers for a long time and harmonises wonderfully both on its own and in combination with a cigar.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

If you're looking for a whisky that scores with character and drinkability, you've found it here - the Cigar Malt 2024 seduces with sweet leather spice and a wonderful tobacco note. Perfect for cozy evenings with a cigar in hand, it simply brings joy to the glass without being overly complicated.

The Cigar Malt 2024 displays an impressive balance between sweet dried fruits, spicy tobacco, and an elegant leather texture that come together harmoniously on the finish. Technically well matured, it convinces with its complex structure, making it an excellent representative of its category, especially for lovers of robust, well-composed whiskies.
