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St. Kilian Double Trouble – Peated

With the special release Double Trouble – Peated, St. Kilian celebrates the 40th anniversary of a cult film, yet keeps the true protagonist in focus: the whisky. Known for its experimental spirit and bold cask choices, this German distillery delivers another striking example. Aged in rare Ramandolo sweet wine casks from northern Italy, this peated single malt masterfully balances power and refinement.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

Intense, sweet, and ashy smoke meets subtle fruity undertones. Notes of ripe figs and apricots blend with a hint of citrus zest. A pleasant maltiness adds depth.

PALATE

Bold and voluminous: Earthy peat smoke expands across the palate, accompanied by a generous dose of spice and prominent oak character. The malty foundation brings a lovely honeyed sweetness, while a delicate fruit sweetness almost feels sugary.

FINISH

The smoke lingers long, underlined by spicy notes with hints of cinnamon and anise. A light tingling sensation and comforting warmth lead to an intense yet balanced conclusion, rounded off by a subtle fruity touch.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

A whisky that really packs a punch and immediately invites you to dive in with its smoky sweetness. Double Trouble – Peated delivers fruity surprises and a great dose of character, ensuring uncompromising drinking pleasure. Not for the faint-hearted, but that's exactly what makes it so exciting!

SASCHA

St. Kilian presents a technically impressive blend of robust peat smoke and nuanced fruity sweetness, supported by an unusual cask maturation. The balance of spice, malt, and oak is well achieved, even though the intensity occasionally slightly overshadows the harmony. A complex, structured peated single malt with real potential.
