Evermann Wilhelm Single Malt Whisky

The Evermann Wilhelm Single Malt Whisky comes from the renowned Bimmerle Distillery in the Black Forest, Germany. Launched in the summer of 2022, the distillery introduced two distinctive whiskies: the blended whisky "Theo" and the single malt "Wilhelm." Wilhelm represents the traditional Black Forest spirit, focusing on regional craftsmanship and a diverse barrel maturation profile.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

The first nosing reveals aromas of red fruits, vanilla, and caramel. Base notes of apple and pear are complemented by a subtle, slightly perfumed oak aroma. The complex aging in seven different cask types—German virgin oak, acacia, American oak, ex-bourbon, sweet wine, chestnut, and Oloroso sherry—provides an unexpectedly deep and harmonious scent profile.

PALATE

On the palate, the single malt impresses with its pleasantly oily mouthfeel and a mild sweetness. Woody caramel and hints of red fruits create an initial impact, while a gentle maltiness rounds off the overall experience. A touch of black pepper adds a pleasant spiciness without overwhelming the palate.

FINISH

The finish is medium-length and shows spicy notes of oak and caramel that gradually fade. The fruity flavors remain subtly in the background, almost reminiscent of bourbon-like traits, but with a more balanced and refined approach.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

A whisky that simply delivers enjoyment without any pretensions, offering cozy moments with its gentle sweetness and red fruit aromas – perfect for relaxed evenings or an easy introduction to the Black Forest whisky scene.

SASCHA

The Evermann Wilhelm presents a well-structured balance between fruitiness, wood notes, and spice, without any striking edges or quirks; a solid, balanced single malt that prioritizes harmony over complexity.
