Fettercairn Warehouse 2 Batch 003

The Fettercairn Warehouse Releases are small batches from the distillery's traditional warehouses in the Scottish Highlands. In the third batch from Warehouse 2, 'Ex-bourbon casks (57%), rum casks (16%) and French red wine barriques (27%) were married together.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

A tantalising mix of honey, flowers and fresh grass rises from the glass. There is also an extra portion of tropical fruits such as mango, pineapple and strawberries, accompanied by a hint of citrus acidity.

PALATE

On the palate, the Fettercairn reveals a lively interplay of spicy ginger, refreshing lemongrass and a hint of white pepper that tingles on the tongue and leaves a pleasant tingling sensation. The malty sweetness is complemented by the appearance of juicy sultanas, while a slightly oily texture gives the mouthfeel a pleasant fullness without being too dry.

FINISH

Although the finish is rather short and weak, it offers a subtle blend of gentle oak and subtle spice that harmonises with a hint of dark chocolate.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

A whisky that lifts the spirits with its lively ginger spice and sweet honey notes – perfect for a relaxed evening without any fuss. While it may lack that certain something, the fruity nuances provide a pleasant drinking experience that shouldn't be underestimated.

SASCHA

Solid complexity meets a well-balanced interplay of spicy and sweet elements, with a pleasantly oily texture. The somewhat short finish slightly detracts from the overall impression, yet the Fettercairn Warehouse 2 Batch 003 impresses with its harmonious structure and clear Highland character.
