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Glenfarclas (2012/2024) The Trinity Vintage Series

Ah, Glenfarclas! The distillery from Speyside, Scotland, has once again conjured up a whisky that is as charming as a Scottish sheepdog in a kilt. The Glenfarclas 2012/2024 The Trinity Vintage Series is a no-age-statement marvel with 46% ABV that doesn't adhere to age limits. But let's dive into this liquid gold and find out why this whisky is a real 'haymaker'.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

Vanilla custard, apple and a pinch of dried apricot join the crumble cake as if they were having a party in a malty orchard. There's also a hint of hay - yes, hay! Not exactly what you'd expect in a whisky, but hey, who needs conventions? This aroma is so inviting that you almost forget to drink the whisky.

PALATE

The first sip is like a sugary-sweet kiss from the orchard. Apricot and hay dance on the tongue, while the soft oak snuggles up to your taste buds like a good friend. The texture is creamy and oily, as if the whisky had decided to bathe itself in rape honey. It's sweet, but not overpowering - like a compliment from someone who really means what they say.

FINISH

The finish is medium to long and leaves you with a smile. The oak makes its presence felt once again, accompanied by a light spiciness and a hint of fruitiness. The honey remains until the end.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

This Glenfarclas is like a sunny afternoon on a Scottish meadow - sweet, charming, and with just enough oak character to keep things interesting. A whisky that's fun and tells stories without trying too hard. For anyone looking for enjoyment with a wink, this one's a bullseye.

The Glenfarclas 2012/2024 impresses with a well-balanced blend of sweet fruit notes and spicy oak that gives the whisky structure and depth. The complexity remains well-controlled without feeling overloaded, making it a solid representative of Speyside.
