## Isle of Jura 30 Years (1994/2024) - Decadent Drinks

Immerse in a tasting experience that begins with a seductive variety of tropical fruits and fine vanilla, while complex spices caress the tongue and provide unexpected depth. Let the clear freshness in the finish carry you away, leaving a lasting impression despite its restraint and prompting reflection.

### TASTING NOTES

#### NOSE

Even at the first contact with the glass, a seductive aroma envelops us, enchanting the senses with a variety of bright fruits. Pineapple and mango penetrate our consciousness, while a gentle vanilla note lies like a delicate veil above it, adding a pleasant sweetness to the scent. A subtle hint of lemon peel brings a refreshing note into play, making the tropical explosion appear even more vibrant. In the background, the wood remains discreetly restrained, which only enhances the inviting atmosphere and gives us the feeling of diving into another world. This harmonious composition awakens anticipation for the first sip and leaves us eagerly awaiting the tasting experience.

#### PALATE

On the palate, an exciting interplay unfolds, where spicy notes of ginger and clove take center stage and immediately stimulate the senses. These spices embrace the tongue and are accompanied by a gentle sweetness reminiscent of vanilla sugar, adding unexpected depth to the flavor. While the fruity freshness that was so enticing in the nose noticeably recedes into the background, a subtle hint of wood resonates, giving the overall picture a pleasant structure. Thus, the impression remains peculiar, as the expected fruitiness one might anticipate due to the inviting aroma does not fully manifest, enriching the tasting experience in an unexpected yet fascinating way.

#### FINISH

In the aftertaste, a pronounced oak presence lingers, unfolding powerfully and giving the experience a solid structure. While the gentle hints of mango resonate discreetly, the freshness ensures a clear, clean impression that caresses the palate. This subtle fruit note harmoniously integrates into the overall picture and leaves room for the complex nuances that unfold in the finish. Despite the interesting components, the aftertaste remains somewhat restrained and does not convey the intense fruitiness one might expect due to the inviting aroma. Thus, this whisky leaves a lasting impression that provokes thought and takes the senses on a gentle yet compelling journey.

### THOUGHTS

#### MARCEL

This whisky leaves a lasting impression that is both fascinating and challenging, as the promised fruity notes fall short of what one hopes for based on the inviting aroma. Those willing to embark on a subtle and complex journey may make an inspiring discovery here that provokes thought.
