Nc'Nean Huntress Lemon Meadow (2019/2025)

The Nc'Nean Distillery, nestled in the Scottish Highlands, is renowned for its commitment to innovation, sustainability, and the exploration of new flavors. Their Huntress series, inspired by Neachneohain—the "Queen of Spirits" from Gaelic mythology—embodies this spirit. The Nc'Nean Huntress Lemon Meadow 2019/2025 continues this journey: a single malt whisky without age statement, bottled at a robust 48.5% ABV, and free from coloring or chill filtration.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

The name "Lemon Meadow" is aptly reflected in the aroma. Initial grassy notes are complemented by a fresh, zesty lemon peel character. Honey, sage, and a hint of rapeseed field add gentle depth. Prominent floral tones complete the bouquet, evoking the image of a blooming spring meadow.

PALATE

On the palate, there's an intriguing shift: the expected floral impression gives way to a mild, fruity sherry note. Flavors of strawberries and red fruit syrup dominate, supported by hints reminiscent of Alpine herbal candies. The whisky remains pleasantly soft and gentle, without losing its vibrancy.

FINISH

The medium-length finish emphasizes wood notes, providing structure to the whisky. Sage aromas reemerge, accompanied by subtle leather nuances, rounding off the experience harmoniously without being overpowering.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

Fresh, lively, and with a charming hint of fruit – the Nc'Nean Huntress Lemon Meadow brings pure drinking pleasure to the glass. Its spring-like aroma profile makes it the perfect companion for mild summer evenings, where you can continually discover new nuances. A whisky that delights with character and lightness, without taking itself too seriously.

SASCHA

An impressively balanced composition where floral freshness and fruity sherry notes harmoniously meet, structured by a solid wood foundation. The Huntress Lemon Meadow demonstrates a clear balance between aromatic complexity and a clean, medium-length finish, making it appealing both to newcomers and seasoned connoisseurs. Technically well-executed, yet with room to grow in depth of complexity.
