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Nine Springs 10 Years PX Finish

A German whisky with a promising reputation that epitomises the passion for special drops. This 10-years whisky with a Pedro Ximénez (PX) sherry finish is 46% vol. So how does this single malt from the Number Nine distillery fare in the world of experienced whisky lovers?

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

The first impression? A veritable explosion of fragrance. The first thing that hits you in the face is an intense cinnamon bun - but really hello, cinnamon lovers will get their money's worth here. The scent of vanilla, blackberries and caramel resonates wonderfully, while a note of grilled peach rises in the background. The sherry influence is clear, but not overwhelming - rather a cosy, warm cloak.

PALATE

In terms of flavour, the Nine Springs goes one better. We really are talking about a sherry bomb here! The sweet honey notes envelop the tongue, accompanied by a juicy peach flavour that is infused with fruity sherry and a hint of caramel. What is particularly striking is that there is no leather or tobacco, as is sometimes found in whiskies with a strong sherry flavour - that would not have been appropriate here. Instead, an almost playful wine gum sweetness creeps in, making the whisky round and pleasant. It is rich, sweet and yet complex enough to make you curious about the next sip.

FINISH

The finish does not disappoint. Spicy, slightly crisp on the tongue and with a pleasant oak note, the Nine Springs finishes in style. It remains present for a long time without imposing itself too much. A hint of dark chocolate mixes in at the end - enough to round off the flavour perfectly, but never stale. The whisky leaves a warm, satisfying feeling.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

This Nine Springs 10 Year PX Finish is a genuine delight for anyone who loves sweet, fruity sherry notes while still seeking a well-balanced character. It's not over the top, but brings a playful wine gum sweetness and a warm finish that offers plenty of drinking pleasure - perfect for cozy evenings with friends.

SASCHA

With its remarkable balance between sweet honey and fruity peach notes, the Nine Springs 10 Year PX Finish demonstrates how German single malt can be structured and harmonious. The subtle sherry influence and the elegant, spicy finish make it a solid example of innovative whisky from Germany, without ever feeling overloaded.
