TASTING NOTES

NOSE

A potpourri of fruit flavours unfolds from the very first nosing: mango, grapefruit and peach characterise the opening and give the whisky a pleasant tropical freshness. These notes are accompanied by a hint of caramel and a nutty flavour of almond and marzipan. The light hints of milk chocolate are particularly charming, adding a subtle sweetness. An inviting start that is uncomplicated and harmonious.

PALATE

On the palate, the Teaninich develops a pleasant freshness, carried by green grapes and red fruits, which give it a lively, fruity flavour. The whisky is wonderfully full-bodied and has a warming presence. The base is reminiscent of fresh cereals - perhaps even a slightly sweet Bircher muesli - with a slightly straw-like and toasted undertone. This combination gives the whisky structure and depth without making it too heavy.

FINISH

The finish is long and balanced, with an unexpected hint of cheese curd that gives the whisky a creamy and slightly sweet component. Light tannins add a touch of dryness, while wet coffee powder and herbal tea add a spicy finish. A successful finish that is not too intrusive and makes you want to take the next sip.

THOUGHTS

MARCEL

A whisky that's simply fun and spreads good cheer with its fruity lightness. The Malaga finish adds a charming twist that neither overwhelms nor bores - perfect for relaxed evenings or as a sweet companion to desserts. Not the most complex Highland, but precisely for that reason so likeable and approachable.

SASCHA

The Teaninich 11 Year Malaga Cask Finish impresses with a balanced harmony between fruity notes and a creamy texture that the Malaga cask expresses with precision. The structure remains clear and well-defined, without being weighed down by excessive complexity - ideal for connoisseurs seeking a harmonious Highland whisky with a solid finish.
