## Wolfburn 10 Years (2023 Release)

Ten years - that's quite a milestone for a young distillery like Wolfburn. Since its foundation in 2013, Scotland's northernmost mainland distillery has made a name for itself with consistent quality and characterful small-batch releases. The 2023 10th anniversary whisky is more than just an anniversary statement - it's a kind of assessment: what can Wolfburn do if given time - and rest?

### TASTING NOTES

#### NOSE

The aroma is multi-layered, but never overloaded: burnt toast, honey, daisies - a mixture of light-coloured fruits such as apple and pear, interspersed with cinnamon, leather and a hint of dark chocolate. It is not a wild ride, but rather a slow, calm unfolding. The flavours stand side by side without drowning each other out.

#### PALATE

What the nose hints at becomes reality on the tongue: milk chocolate, sultanas, a little date and burnt caramel. The dram has a dark character without being heavy. It is creamy, round and scores with hints of nutmeg and - very subtle - strawberry in the background.

#### FINISH

The finish is rather short, but harmonious: sweet coffee, coffee grounds, a little bitter, but pleasantly woody. A fine sherry note shimmers through, never dominant, more like a greeting from afar. No drama, no fireworks.

### THOUGHTS

#### MARCEL

A whisky that quietly convinces and invites you to linger with its gentle character. Wolfburn 10 Years isn't a firework, but that's exactly what makes it the perfect everyday dram - honest, rounded, and pleasantly approachable. For anyone looking for an uncomplicated Highland whisky with heart, it's a real winner.

#### SASCHA

The Wolfburn 10 Years displays a remarkable balance between fruitiness and spicy sherry notes without ever feeling overloaded. Its clear structure and subtle complexity make it a solid representative of the young Highland distilleries, standing out especially through its harmonious bottling. For lovers of well-composed, mature whiskies, it offers a convincing benchmark.
